

MEDICAMP 2021 SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Scholarships

MediCamp will offer **two** student Scholarships to attend MediCamp UWC 2021 to individuals aged 16-18 year-old within the UK.

1. One full **Local** Student Scholarship: One applicant who attends an educational setting within Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan will be awarded a full Scholarship to attend MediCamp UWC 2021. The course fee of £2450 will therefore be waived.
2. One full **National** Student Scholarship: One successful applicant from an educational setting within the UK will be awarded a full Scholarship to attend MediCamp UWC 2021. The course fee of £2450 will therefore be waived.

Applicants who apply for the Full Local Student Scholarship will automatically be entered into the Full National Student Scholarship competition also.

Entry for applications will close at midnight on the 11th April. Top entries will then be shortlisted no more than **7** days after the application deadline closes. Voting for the winning entries will then be open for **7** days after the shortlisted entries have been announced.

Applicants may be asked to undertake an interview either in-person at UWC Atlantic or virtually prior to the awarding of Scholarships.

MediCamp UWC reserves the right to not award Scholarships if suitable applications are not received

Cancellation

UWC Atlantic reserves the right to cancel the course up to 7 days before the start date due to unforeseen circumstances or if numbers enrolled have not reached the minimum requirement. Whilst all efforts will be made to offer a suitable alternative course, if this is not practicable or is not deemed suitable, a full refund will be offered.

Participant Withdrawal

UWC Atlantic reserves the right to withdraw any participant from a course for any behavior we deem to be detrimental to the smooth-running of the course or which might interfere with the safety of any other participants on the course.

Any non-disclosure of medical, other conditions or personal circumstances which require significant support or may otherwise affect the participant's ability to complete the course will result in the student being withdrawn. Any associated costs of such support will be the liability of the parent or guardian.
