





You will engage and lead participants from all around the world and provide pastoral support for children and young people ranging from 8-18 years old.

A selection of up to 12 enthusiastic volunteers will work together on this exciting range of activities, events and projects all based on our amazing campus by the sea.

This is an unprecedented time and we know that by investing in you as leaders we can provide an exceptional opportunity to develop personally and grow leadership skills.

THE ROLE OF THE ACTIVITY LEADERSHIP VOLUNTEERS

Once formal training and induction has been completed volunteers will be expected to:

- Plan, lead and deliver the range of activities
- Support the general operations of UWC Atlantic Experience
- Provide residential pastoral support to children and young people residing at the College
- Support the ideals and ethos of the UWC movement

Our training programme covers a range of topics from leadership, reflection and experiential learning, to diversity and international awareness.

You will have the opportunity to achieve nationally-recognised qualifications, activity-specific training, as well as completing compulsory safeguarding training.

Full board and lodging will be provided in our 12th-Century castle; a pretty unique home for a once in a lifetime experience.

NEED TO KNOW

- Suited candidates will ideally be aged 21-25
- All volunteers will need to arrive at the College on or before Friday 28th May 2021
- The opportunity lasts until 31st August 2021 and it is expected that volunteers would commit to completing this time period
- Assistance with transport can be provided from local travel stations (e.g. Cardiff, Bridgend) upon request
- All volunteers will receive full board and lodging on campus
- We can only accept applications from those who do not require a visa and/or have no legal requirement to quarantine on arrival at the College
- Applications will need to undertake a full DBS check prior to commencing the volunteer programme
- Applications must be submitted by Friday 9th April 2021
- Candidates must be available for a video interview during the week of 12th April
 2021
- All applicants must agree to the UWC Volunteer Code of Conduct as well as the Volunteer Role Expectations
