The 12th-Century St Donat's Castle is steeped above Tudor gardens, overlooking the Vale Heritage Coast. The castle was bought by Antonin Besse II in 1960 and donated to the founding council of UWC Atlantic.

Please note you are only permitted on the ground floor.






ARTS CENTRE
