

St Donats Summer Fayre - accessibility guide

Dear visitors

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our site. To ensure you have the best experience possible, we have put together this guide for our accessibility measures on site.

Parking

The main parking location is on a grassy field, a 5-10 minute walk from the grounds. This includes a brief walk over uneven ground before joining the tarmac road on the grounds. For accessible parking, please follow the normal entry route for cars - our staff will be able to direct you to our accessible parking from there. Please note this is subject to availability, but we will do our best to accommodate your needs.

Facilities

There are accessible toilets on site in the following locations:

- St Donats Art Centre (accessible via lift)
- Seafront (opposite male toilets)
- Castle (accessible through a door on the right-hand side of the castle courtyard please follow the signs)

Getting around the grounds

Due to the historical nature of our site, there are some uneven surfaces in the castle gardens. Seating is located in the gardens to provide points for rest if needed.

To get inside the castle, please follow the signs for 'accessible entry'.

The access to the seafront is either via our gardens (uneven ground, steps), or on the road. The walk back up is along a steep hill.
